Submission guidelines are as follows:

Step 1:

Using the Entry Form on page 2, please incorporate all required entry information into the email using one of two methods:

1. Copy and paste the information into the body of the email and answer the fields within the body of the email OR
2. Print and fill it out, scan it, save it as a PDF and attach it to your email entry.

Step 2:

Attach high-quality images of your work that are saved as JPEGs (800 pixels wide x 600 pixels high) and named as follows: Last Name First Name_#_Title_Dimensions_Materials_Price

Entries submitted without photos cannot be accepted.

Artists accepted into the exhibit will be notified on April 15. The work is insured and judging will be done by a local committee of knowledgeable art professionals. A 30% commission for any sculptures sold will be taken by the City of Concord to promote the visual arts.
